We invite you to join in prayer as we embark on this adventure. Let us pray specifically for God to lead us as a church family, to pray for the Ministry Campaign Committee, to pray for each other, and the ministry that we have been entrusted with.

This booklet is formatted into seven week periods, with each day of the week having a different prayer focus.

***Sunday – Will focus on a Heart of Worship.***

***Monday – Will focus on our own Spiritual Growth.***

***Tuesday – Will focus on the Unity of the “Body of Christ”.***

***Wednesday – Will focus on Ministry at Liberty Lake Community Church and Surrounding area.***

***Thursday – Will focus on prayer for Leaders, present and future.***

***Friday – Will focus on seeking wisdom about our building project.***

***Saturday – Will focus on praying about giving and stewardship.***

Throughout the next 50 days we would encourage you to use this prayer adventure during your personal devotion in your home, small groups, adult classes at church, Kids ROCK, and any gathering that might be scheduled throughout this time. Blank pages have also been included in the back of this booklet for you to journal your thoughts as you pray.

**Pray Today** that we as individuals, and as Liberty Lake Community Church, would be salt and light to those that do not know Christ as Savior.

**Day 5 - Thursday**

To the elders among you, a witness of Christ's sufferings and one who also will share in the glory to be revealed: Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your care, serving as overseers--not because you must, but because you are willing, as God wants you to be; not greedy for money, but eager to serve; not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock.

**-1 Peter 5:1-3**

**Pray Today** for wisdom for our elders (Pastoral Leadership Team) as they shepherd and lead this church family.

**Day 6 - Friday**

I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you and watch over you.

**-Psalm 32:8**

**Pray Today** that God will give our church family direction and confirmation about this building project.

**Day 7 - Saturday**

Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.

**-2 Corinthians 9:7**

**Pray Today** that we would give to the Lord what He has placed on our hearts with a cheerful heart and attitude.





## Day 50 - Sunday

In God we make our boast all day long, and we will praise your name forever.

*Psalm 44:8*

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

*- Hebrews 13:8*

**Pray Today** *Praise God for His faithfulness and His direction in our lives and in the life of our church family.*



## Day 11- Wednesday

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength. These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts. Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.

*- Deuteronomy 6:4-7*

**Pray Today** *that we will be committed to passing God's Word on to the next generations. Pray that our Children's Ministry would be used by God to help kids and families in their walk with the Lord.*

## Day 12 - Thursday

And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others.

*- 2 Timothy 2:2*

**Pray Today** *that God would raise up leaders in LLCC and that we would be developing them in our midst.*

## Day 13 - Friday

Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encourage one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.

*- Hebrews 10:23-25*

**Pray Today** *Pray that a building would be a ministry tool, a place where we can gather as the church to encourage each other with the Word of God.*

## Day 14 - Saturday

In this case, moreover, it is required of stewards that one be found trustworthy

*-1 Corinthians 4:2*

**Pray Today** *that we would be good stewards individually and as a church family of all that God has entrusted to us.*

## Week Three

### Day 15 - Sunday

Shout for joy to the LORD, all the earth. Worship the LORD with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. Know that the LORD is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture. Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. For the LORD is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations.

*-Psalm 100*

**Pray Today** asking God to fill our hearts with joy and thanksgiving as we come to worship Him today.

### Day 16 - Monday

Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.

*-Joshua 1:8*

**Pray Today** that we would meditate on God's Word; and that He would give us strength to be used for His plans and purposes.

### Day 17 - Tuesday

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles. All the believers were together and had everything in common. Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need. Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

*-Acts 2:42-47*

**Pray Today** that we would be devoted to ministering and caring for each other. Pray also that we would remain committed today and always to the teaching and preaching of God's Word.

**Pray Today** that we will be preaching the good news of Jesus Christ to those that have not heard it, both near and far. Take some time to pray for the neighbors, co-workers, or friends that you would like to share the Good News with.

### Day 47- Thursday

After that, he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around him ... Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you.

*- John 13:5,14,15*

**Pray Today** that we would develop a servants heart as we serve the Lord and one another.

### Day 48 - Friday

Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock.

*- Matthew 7:24,25*

**Pray Today** that we would be wise builders, first by putting God's Word into practice in our lives, and secondly by seeking God for wisdom as we consider a facility for ministry.

### Day 49 - Saturday

Yours, O LORD, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the majesty and the splendor, for everything in heaven and earth is yours. Yours, O LORD, is the kingdom; you are exalted as head over all. Wealth and honor come from you; you are the ruler of all things. In your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all. Now, our God, we give you thanks, and praise your glorious name. "But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand.

*-1 Chronicles 29:11-14*

**Pray Today** that we would realize that all we have comes from God, and that we will give Him thanks. Pray also that we will be able to give to the Lord generously for what He has called us to do as His church.

## Week Seven

### Day 43 - Sunday

Worship the LORD in the splendor of his holiness;  
- *Psalm 96:9*

"You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being."  
- *Revelation 4:11*

*Pray Today that we would see the beauty of the Lord and His Holiness, and be moved to worship.*

### Day 44 - Monday

Above all else, guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life.  
- *Proverbs 4:23*

I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.  
- *Psalm 119: II*

*Pray Today that we would fill our hearts with God's Word so that we will honor Him in all that we do each day.*

### Day 45 - Tuesday

My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me. I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one: I in them and you in me. May they be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.  
- *John 17:20-23*

*Pray Today that our unity would give testimony to Jesus Christ and that He is our Savior.*

### Day 46 - Wednesday

How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written, How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!  
- *Romans 10:14,15*

### Day 18 - Wednesday

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.  
- *Acts 1:8*

*Pray Today that we will be witnesses for Christ, in our community, in our country, and in the world. Pray for our church sponsored mission. Pray that God would allow us, and our brothers and sisters in these churches to spread His Good News to those that have not heard.*

### Day 19 - Thursday

Brothers, choose seven men from among you who are known to be full of the Spirit and wisdom. We will turn this responsibility over to them and will give our attention to prayer and the ministry of the word. This proposal pleased the whole group. They chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit;  
- *Acts 6:3-5a*

*Pray Today that God would raise up men and women to be apart of the leadership teams for this building project.*

### Day 20 - Friday

Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall.  
- *Proverbs 16:18*

*Pray Today that a facility, building project, or anything that we do would never be a source of personal pride.*

### Day 21 - Saturday

And now, brothers, we want you to know about the grace that God has given the Macedonian churches. Out of the most severe trial, their overflowing joy and their extreme poverty welled up in rich generosity. For I testify that they gave as much as they were able, and even beyond their ability. Entirely on their own, they urgently pleaded with us for the privilege of sharing in this service to the saints. And they did not do as we expected, but they gave themselves first to the Lord and then to us in keeping with God's will.  
- *2 Corinthians 8:1-5*

*Pray Today that God would lead us, and give us the heart and ability to give generously for His plans.*

## Week Four

### Day 22 - Sunday

Of all the commandments, which is the most important? The most important one, answered Jesus, is this: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no commandment greater than these.

- **Mark 12:28-31**

**Pray Today** that we will love God with all that we are, and in all that we do, and that this would be reflected in our lives.

### Day 23 - Monday

So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him, rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness.

- **Col: 2:6,7**

**Pray Today** that our faith is growing and being rooted in Jesus.

### Day 24 - Tuesday

Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues, put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

- **Col 3:12-14**

**Pray Today** that God will clothe us with love for one another, and that we will reflect His character toward each other.

### Day 25 - Wednesday

Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is--his good, pleasing and perfect will.

- **Romans 12:2**

**Pray Today** that our children will be transformed by God's Word and His working in their lives. Pray that they will honor Christ with the decisions they make.

### Day 40 - Thursday

It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers, to prepare God's people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be; built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

-**Ephesians 4:11-13**

**Pray Today** being thankful for those that God has used in the church to be leaders, evangelists, pastors, teachers in our lives, to teach us and prepare us for His work Thank Him for that specific person that He has used to make an impact in your life.

### Day 41- Friday

For in Scripture it says: See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame.

-**1 Peter 2:6**

**Pray Today** even though this verse is not talking about a physical building, pray that Christ would be the cornerstone of all of the ministries of LLCC, whether outside or in the buildings that God has allowed us have.

### Day 42 - Saturday

If I give all I possess to the poor and surrender my body to the flames, but have not love, I gain nothing. Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails.

-**1 Corinthians 13:3-8a**

**Pray Today** that our giving would be out of a heart of love for the Lord and for one another.



## Week Six

### Day 36 - Sunday

Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable his judgments, and his paths beyond tracing out! "Who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has been his counselor?" "Who has ever given to God, that God should repay him?" For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be the glory forever! Amen.

- *Romans 11:33-36*

**Pray Today** that we will reflect on the majesty and awe of God and worship Him.

### Day 37 - Monday

Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already been made perfect, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me. Brothers, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

- *Philippians 3:12-14*

**Pray Today** that God would give us the strength to continue to press on and to know and follow Him more and more in our lives.

### Day 38 - Tuesday

Also in Judah the hand of God was on the people to give them unity of mind to carry out what the king and his officials had ordered, following the word of the LORD.

- *2 Chronicles 30:12*

**Pray Today** that God would give us one mind and one heart to carry out what He has called us to do through His Word.

### Day 39 - Wednesday

All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

- *2 Tim. 3:16,17*

**Pray Today** that we will be an equipping church and that a future facility will be a place where further equipping can take place and people can be prepared to serve the Lord.

### Day 26 - Thursday

...but those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

- *Isaiah 40:31*

**Pray Today** for strength for all those that are serving in our church family, whether they are Kids ROCK, Mens Ministry, Womens Ministry, Student ministries, setting up chairs, serving on a leadership team, or in so many other ways.

### Day 27 - Friday

Some trust in chariots and, some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.

- *Psalms 20: 7*

**Pray Today** that our hope and trust is always in God, and not our ability to have buildings (not in horses / chariots).

### Day 28 - Saturday

They received from Moses all the offerings the Israelites had brought to carry out the work of constructing the sanctuary. And the people continued to bring freewill offerings morning after morning. So all the skilled craftsmen who were doing all the work on the sanctuary left their work and said to Moses, "The people are bringing more than enough for doing the work the LORD commanded to be done." Then Moses gave an order and they sent this word throughout the camp: "No man or woman is to make anything else as an offering for the sanctuary." And so the people were restrained from bringing more, because what they already had was more than enough to do all the work.

- *Exodus 36:3-7*

**Pray Today** that if we build that God would provide more than enough resources to do all the work.



## Week Five

### Day 29 - Sunday

So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God.

*-1 Corinthians 10:31*

**Pray Today** *that we would bring worship / honor to God today and each day throughout the week.*

### Day 30 - Monday

For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come.

*-1 Timothy 4:8*

**Pray Today** *that we would be building godly character into our lives. In what areas of your life is God working today? Ask Him for strength as you grow.*

### Day 31- Tuesday

May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you a spirit of unity among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus, so that with one heart and mouth you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

*- Romans 15: 5,6*

**Pray Today** *that we will together as one lift up and proclaim the name of Jesus.*

### Day 32 - Wednesday

Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

*- Matthew 28:18 20*

**Pray Today** *that God would help us to carry out the "Great Commission." Lord help us to be making disciples that follow your teaching in all parts of the world.*

### Day 33 - Thursday

What you heard from me, keep as the pattern of sound teaching, with faith and love in Christ Jesus. Guard the good deposit that was entrusted to you--guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit who lives in us.

*- 2 Timothy 1:13,14*

Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood. I know that after I leave, savage wolves will come in among you and will not spare the flock. Even from your own number men will arise and distort the truth in order to draw away disciples after them. So be on your guard!

*-Acts 20:28 31*

**Pray Today** *for our elders, that they would have wisdom and discernment as they shepherd this church family, and that we will all hold to the sound teaching of the Word of God.*

### Day 34 - Friday

When they arrived, they went upstairs to the room where they were staying. Those present were Peter, John, James and Andrew; Philip and Thomas, Bartholomew and Matthew; James son of Alphaeus and Simon the Zealot, and Judas son of James. They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers.

*- Acts 1:13,14*

**Pray Today** *that our current facility and any future buildings will be a place where we will gather to pray and seek God in the midst of ministry.*

### Day 35 - Saturday

The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it.

*- Psalm 24:1a*

Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

*- Matthew 6:19 21*

**Pray Today** *thanking God for all the ways He has provided for you, and also pray that we will use what He has entrusted to us for His Kingdom. Ask God to give us wisdom as individuals and as a church family to use His resources for treasures in heaven.*
