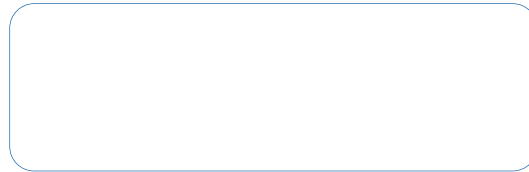

## BUILDING PLANS ARE PROGRESSING

The building committee is working with Architects West and the City of Liberty Lake to develop an acceptable and approvable site plan. The pre-application meeting is complete and the plans are moving forward.

Architects West has prepared a draft of the first phase and we will soon have a three-dimensional, 360° view available on the Website.
