4. Give an example of what loving God with all of your heart, soul, mind, and strength looks like to you. (Mark 12:28-34)
5. What heart attitude does God long to see in you? Why is it so important? (Psalm 51:16-17)
6. What were several things about God that caused David to worship Him? (1 Chronicles 29:10-14)
7. What is the result when we ignore God's creative power, ignore our conscience, and turn from God rather than responding in love toward Him? Romans 1:18-32; Psalm 14:1
8. How does your life demonstrate to your family and friends that loving God is your priority?
